Expect to learn about what to do if you are lost, how to respond to minor injuries, build outdoor leadership skills for youth and adults, engage in thoughtful discussions about how we interact with places, and more. **This workshop does not award any sort of certification of skills;** this is purely a skills awareness and development opportunity for families.
