Join Julie Beeler, instructor at PNCA and OCAC, at her Trout Lake studio and flower farm, Bloom & Dye. We will harvest farm fresh indigo and spend our time dyeing silk scarves in fresh leaf indigo and a linen dish towel with dried leaf indigo. Everyone will learn the science behind indigo and experience the magic and beauty of blue. We will play with different Japanese shibori techniques to create design patterns and you will bring home a beautifully hand-dyed silk scarf and linen dish towel.
